

Projektor is an application for presenting PDFs on a computer which is connected to a second monitor. It is optimized for displaying documents created with \LaTeX beamer. However, it works with any PDF document.

It comes with a presenter view, which is dedicated to give notes a big area.

As an additional feature, it is able to integrate notes written in a text editor.

Some times there is a need to draw some additional information, right during the presentation, into a slide. For this situation you are well prepared with Projektor. It comes with a free hand drawing mode, where you can draw live during a presentation on the slides. The desired color can be selected and the altered slide can be saved as a PNG file. In fact, your drawing is saved automatically, when the slide changes.



To keep the PDF document and the notes together, Projektor uses its own container format.

It is a quite simple format which can easily be handcrafted.

Notes can be created either by hand or during a normal \LaTeX run. For the latter to work a dedicated \LaTeX style file `pdcnnotes.sty` has to be included.

In addition, Projektor is also capable of editing and saving notes.



As already mentioned, Projektor is able to let you draw on the current slide. You can easily draw on the current slide shown in the presenter screen while it directly shows up on the presentation screen as well. To let you keep your focus on the presentation, all drawings are saved automatically when the slide is changed. Therefore, you can go over them after the presentation and send the selected to the attendees. The name format is:

`DOCUMENTNAME_SLIDENUMBER_YYYY-MM-DD_HH-MM-SS.png`.



Due to Apples restrictions this application is sandboxed to met all the requirements. With this, some directories may be located under strange path like Users ▶ USERNAME ▶ Library ▶ Containers ▶ info.andreasfertig.Projektor ▶ Data ▶ Documents. For your convenience, there is a menu item which opens the location in finder:

Help » Show Saved Drawings in Finder.

As a result of this restriction, Projektor is unable to open a corresponding note file aside a PDF in any other folder than Downloads or Pictures.
